# Collections

**Statutes:** Each metro county law library contains a copy of the Minnesota and federal statutes. They also provide online access to statutes from other states.

**Other Legislative Material:** The libraries maintain collections of historical legislative material, including session laws and statutes from previous years. Some libraries also contain federal legislative history material.

**Court Rules:** All of the libraries have copies of court rules, which dictate the procedure of the courts.

**Regulations:** Each library contains the laws created by Minnesota's agencies. You will also have access to federal regulations, either in print or online.

**Ordinances:** The county law libraries are depositories for municipal ordinances.

**Self Help Materials:** The libraries offer many self help resources, both in print and online.

**Forms:** The law libraries contain books of various legal forms, and access to many more forms online.

**Case Law:** Each county law library has case law from Minnesota state and federal courts. Case law from other states is also available online.

**Treatises & Encyclopedias:** The libraries have many books that describe, analyze and explain the law.

## Reference Assistance

Each metro county law library is staffed by a professional librarian who can assist you with finding materials and resources.

## Access to Electronic Legal Resources

The libraries subscribe to electronic databases that you may use while in the library. These services provide access to: case law, statutes, regulations, legal treatises and practice materials.

## Courts Self Help Center

Each library has access to a workstation that connects to the Minnesota State Courts Self Help Center website. The center includes links to court forms and legal information as well as contact information for phone and online help.

## Circulation
